"I invite us to journey together as neighbors imagining what this world would look like through our faith traditions.


What would it look like for everyone to have safe and affordable housing?

As we are here tonight to help create a vision that sees a way for all of us to have a just society whereby all have affordable housing, access to mental health treatment, and kids have a second chance.


So, let our faith continue to guide us forward as we work together to live into this divine vision of hope whereby there is peace and justice for all!"

JUSTICE AND PEACE MINISTRIES

Compass Pride Event and Nehemiah Action: The last week in March was a busy one for the Justice and Peace Team. Ministry members attended Union's booth at the Compass Pride event in Lake Worth on March 25 and March 26. Many people stopped by Union's booth to learn more about Union, some took a free Bible (Union's Spiritual Food project) and some purchased Peace Quilt items. Fifteen Union members attended the annual PEACE Nehemiah Action on March 27. The three issues being addressed at this year's Action were Affordable Housing, Mental Health & Addiction and Police-Community Relations. Since last fall, members of Union's J & P Team have worked diligently on all three issues to research and prepare for this event.

Haitian Women's Crafts Project:

Union's Justice and Peace Ministry has undertaken a new project to help the women of Haiti. Thanks to the sponsorship of Peace Quilts, an economic development organization, member owned women's sewing cooperatives have been started up in Haiti to produce a variety of handcrafted items. Each purchase of a craft item alleviates poverty in Haiti through job creation. All the money collected from the sale of these beautiful handcrafted items, handmade jewelry and metal art creations goes directly to this worthy cause. In addition to selling the items at the Compass Pride event, Union's J & P Team has been selling them in Fellowship Hall during Holy Week.

Did You Know?

At least 18 bills have been filed in the Florida Legislature that target transgender citizens. These bills are designed to regulate where trans people can use the bathroom, whether they can access health care and the extent to which they can express themselves in public. For example, the aim of one of the proposals is to expand Florida's "Don't Say Gay" parental rights law. The current law *restricts classroom instruction on sexual orientation and gender identity in grades K-3. The current bills in the House and Senate seek to apply the restriction from pre-K through Grade 8. Other bills would restrict access to gender-affirming care for both children and adults.* Taken from an article in the Palm Beach Post, March 16, 2023.


