JUSTICE AND PEACE UPDATES

I am excited to announce that some additional tours have been added to the Justice and Peace Intergenerational Trip to Washington D.C. The National Mall Bus Tour has been added as well as an NAACP tour and talk. These are in addition to the tour of the African American Museum of History and Culture, a visit to Capitol Hill for Lobby Day, and a visit to the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial. Eight adults and four youth will attend this social justice trip from June 20 - 22.

On May 26, 2023, PEACE published a response to FL Senate Bill 1718 which has recently been passed. This bill prohibits local governments from funding the Community ID programs that PEACE helped initiate. The Community ID Program was created to provide all residents of Palm Beach County with a form of ID if they do not have a way of obtaining an ID by traditional methods. In 2022 PEACE pushed the Board of County Commissioners to allocate \$75,000 to fund the administration of this essential program. Because Senate Bill 1718 has been passed, the funding for the Community ID program is now in jeopardy. In its published response, PEACE vows to keep working to ensure that all of its programs, including the Community ID Program will continue in Palm Beach County.


