




FLOWERS FOR THE SANCTUARY

TRUSTEE NEWS AUGUST 2024

The Trustees continue to meet the second Sunday evening of each month throughout the summer. At these meetings the Trustees focus on the Finances of the church, the facility and the growth of the Love of Christ in our community.

Finances: At our last meeting we discussed the fact that the summer months are slow in terms of donations. We have had to go to our Endowment Fund two times. The Trustees are working with the Stewardship team to brainstorm ideas for increasing financial support of our church.

Facility: The roof repairs have been completed and we feel the roof is ready for the rainy (sometimes stormy) season. We have added the Fire Alarm board as in need of replacement. ATT, our phone line service, has made us aware that our out-of-date alarm board requires a phone line to connect it to the fire department and our board is currently using an analog line. This has become increasingly expensive (\$175 a month) since analog is being phased out. We will need to switch to a digital alarm (would only be \$20 a month). The Trustees are investigating this in addition to our need to eventually replace one of the sanctuary AC systems and one of the Lift Station pumps.

Growth: The Trustees continue to support our WAMM and our Fellowship teams, as WAMM has been working tirelessly to improve our Live Stream and sound system, allowing us to reach our 'out of the area' members as well as our inchurch service; and we enjoyed creating after worship Fellowship activities in June, including a July 4th indoor picnic and Juneteenth and Pride celebrations.

The Trustees appreciate all the volunteers who help out in all three of these areas! Bob Smith works on the grounds almost every Saturday and welcomes anyone who would like to assist and we have a handful of other 'angels' who always help out in the kitchen (David!) and others who continue to help us with the smaller repair jobs that come up now and then. And then there are those of you who come to worship (in person or online). Your presence is gift to God!

We could not do this without your Love for the church!


SENIOR HOUSING UPDATE - AUG 2024

Union's Affordable Senior Housing project is progressing. We have been given the "Green Light" by the County to move forward in our Mission.

Our developer, Green Mills, has made the decision to wait until the next funding cycle to apply for funding for our project. They are feeling very positive about the support from both the Board of County Commissioners and the Building & Zoning Board -but the application requirements for funding is complex and calls for a need for more area studies and drawings. They feel more time is needed to make a strong application. Our goal is to be successful in the funding process, so we support Green Mills as they complete the application process.
